Program: The Center for International Understanding's 2012 Health and Policy Program will provide NC leaders with resources and information to create practical, insightful solutions that incorporate a better understanding of Latino/Hispanic cultures into health care delivery. In Mexico and the U.S. participants will explore different avenues to ensure best use of resources and achieve better health outcomes.

Program Components:

- Program orientation (Sept 14, 2012)
- 7-day Study in Mexico (Oct 8-14, 2012)
- Planning for Change workshop (Nov 15, 2012)
- Update forum (May 2013)

Program Cost: approximately \$4500

Eligibility: Hospital and public health department administrators, social workers, health care practitioners, and Latino professionals interested in developing strategies to improve care and increase awareness of health care concerns in the Latino community are eligible.
