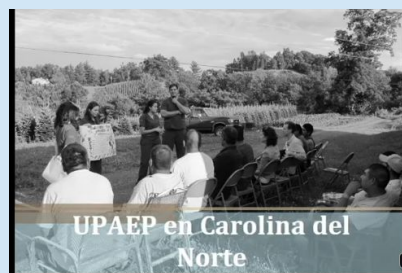

ALL NEW: Latino Leadership Training Course

Led by the 2010 Wake County Latino Initiative Alumni, and others, Raleigh's first Latino Leadership Training Course will begin later this month!



Thirty-three students have signed up to participate in this 8 session course. The goal is to provide Spanish-speakers in Raleigh with information about a variety of area services and ways in which they can become more engaged. The course will help agencies develop relationships with emerging leaders who will then disseminate the information to their community. Some of the session topics include: community safety, health, drop-out prevention and financial services, among others.
